## A Message from Will

This half term has seemed to have flown by! As the saying goes "Time flies when you're having fun". It has been a joy for school to return to normality after the last 18 months. To be able to see the children once again join together in year groups and hear them singing. Children in Year 2 being able to cross bubbles and take part in mixed group daily supported reading at the start of the day. Children being able to mix and take part in specialist sports coaching and enter inter-school competitions (see later in newsletter). The restart and increase of Art and DT extra-curricular clubs. The whole Yr2 year session in the lower hall yesterday afternoon lead by Annie Ray for the children to hear and learn about Handel's Water Music, and experience Annie playing along with her French horn! Over the last few weeks, senior leaders have had the opportunity to undertake 'Learning Walks' across the school and visit classes to see the children learning. It was uplifting for us to see their excellent attitudes and behaviour, and the quality and rapid progress they were making in their learning. I would also like to thank you for your support in relation to Covid, keeping your children at home and getting them tested if they develop symptoms, and keeping us informed. If your child is now in Year 3, please remember that you will have to start paying for your school meal, therefore it is very important that we have the correct meal type on the system for your child.

## Items in School

A reminder that children aren't to bring in toys and items into school, such as soft toys, poppers, fidget spinners, etc.

This is to save the risk of items being broken or lost, and to stop any arguments that may be caused by them. With regards to collectable cards, we know that the children enjoy bringing their cards in and swapping them with other children at break times, which can also be a good lesson for the children to learn with regards to cooperation and understanding. To minimize disruption, we will be allowing children to bring cards in to swap only on Fridays, so please make sure your child doesn't bring in their cards on other days.

## School Menu

After the half term the school menu will be changing to a new Autumn/Spring menu. The school menu runs on a three-week rotation which includes vegetarian options on each day. ## School Start Time Reminder

This is a reminder to parents and carers of the start times for the children of different year groups:

- Nursery - **9am start time** - Please go straight to the Nursery entrance
- Reception - **8:45am start time** - Please go straight to the Reception classroom door entrance
- Year 1 - **8:55am start time** - Please line up in the correct class line, near the Infant building entrance
- Year 2 - **8:55am start time** - Please line up by the classroom door entrance
- Year 3 - **8:55am start time** - Please line up at your allotted location in the playground (as per the map sent previously)
- Year 4 - **8:50am soft start (children can go straight to their classrooms) - 8:55am start time**
- Year 5 - **8:50am soft start (children can go straight to their classrooms) - 8:55am start time**
- Year 6 - **8:50am soft start (children can go straight to their classrooms) - 8:55am start time**

Please note that if your child arrives **after 8:55am** they must go to the main office to register their attendance, and then proceed to class.

For children in Reception or Year 1, if you arrive late please buzz on the infant building buzzer to let the office know which child has arrived and then a member of staff will come and collect them from the entrance. No adults are allowed to enter the Infant or Junior school building.

The finish times continue as they have been, with the Nursery finishing as per their hours at Nursery, the Reception finishing at 3:10pm, and Years 1-6 finishing at 3:25pm.

## Late Starters

Please remember that class for the Juniors starts at 8:55am, so children need to be in their class and ready for the register at this time. If it is raining in the morning, then the children are allowed to enter the lower hall at 8:45am, and then proceed to class at 8:50pm (soft start) with the class actually starting at 8:55am as it would be normally. Parents and carers don't need to join the children in the lower hall if it is raining as there will be staff there to supervise the children.

If your child is regularly late in the mornings this can be really distressing for the child entering the class late, but it can also be very disruptive for the rest of the class. Please remember to be on time.

While the boiler is now fixed and up and running there are a few more things they need to check which will take place over the half term. Once this is complete the bike/scooter shed will need to be repositioned and secured before we can allow children to keep their bikes and scooters in there. We will confirm once it is ready, so in the meantime please continue to take any bikes or scooters home with you.
