

#### Nursery for January 2024 start

If your child will be 3 years old by 31<sup>st</sup> December 2023 then there is a possibility that we will be able to offer Nursery places for a January 2024 start. #### Nut-Free School

Please remember that we are a nut-free school, this includes After School Club. Please don't bring an After School Club snack for your child that includes nuts, such as; peanut butter sandwiches, granola bars (as many also contain nuts), etc.

#### **School Payments**

As an on-going reminder we'd like to make sure parents and carers keep up to date with their school payments. You can make payment via School Gateway using your mobile and email address. If you are having any troubles with creating an account or logging in, please make sure that the office has the most up-to-date information for you.

### Reporting Absences and Late Collections

If you need to report your child absent for any reason (sickness, appointment, etc) then please make sure you do this through the voicemail service on the phone, or through a text on School Gateway. Please <u>don't</u> email the admin email address as this is not continually monitored, especially during busy periods so may not be seen until later in the day.

For any late collections or if someone different is collecting, please also call directly to the office with as much notice as possible so that it can be passed onto the teacher

#### Snacks for School / Clubs

We'd like to remind parents and carers that children in Yr3-6 are allowed to bring in a piece of fruit or vegetables to have during morning playtime. Please don't let your child bring in anything other than fruit or vegetables. As we are a healthy school, this also continues into the After School Club and all activity clubs. Your child is allowed to bring in snacks but please make sure these don't include chocolate, biscuits, crisps, sweets, and NO NUTS at all.

#### Emails from the School

#### After School Club Update

On Thursday 5<sup>th</sup> October – there will be no ASC collection from the Lunch Hall. Year 4,5,6 parents are to collect from the main ASC room just for this day. Parents/carers need to provide healthy snacks for ASC; no chocolates, crisps or fizzy drinks.

All payments for ASC being made through childcare vouchers or Tax-Free Government payments, should be paid into the <u>Bounds Green Juniors</u> account, even if your child is in Infants.

#### **Reception Children Meal Types September 2023**

Reception children are all entitled to have a <u>Universal free school meal</u>, if you would like to see what your child is having for lunch each day, please see link for our school menu:

We find that by parents being able to see what the children are eating, they can have conversations with them the night before about what is available and what they might like, which helps the smaller children try new things.

On the other hand, if you find your child is struggling to eat and would like to change them onto a different meal type, please email Ashleigh in the office on <u>arobertson@boundsgreen.haringey.sch.uk</u> Each child in school needs to be either 'school meals' or 'packed lunch', unfortunately you cannot swap meal types each day as the kitchen pre-orders the food in advance.

#### Juniors School Meals Information September 2023

The Mayor of London has implemented that every child in Years 3-6 for one academic school year only (end date July 2024), will be allowed to have free meals. If your child is still having a packed lunch and you would like to change meal type please email Ashleigh in the school office

on <u>arobertson@boundsgreen.haringey.sch.uk</u> and she will give you a date your child can start this meal change. If your child was having a school meal from last academic year, this has continued into this year so you don't have to do anything.

If you have an outstanding amount for school meals owing from last year, a new payment request on School Gateway will be available for those parents to clear their debt.

All debts need to clear as soon as possible- if you have a high debt and unable to clear this in one payment and need support please email Ashleigh and she can support you in payment plans etc.
