Every School in the country is allocated money each year to develop sporting and encourage healthy lifestyles. We use the PE and Sport premium to secure improvements in the following 5 areas to promote engagement of all pupils in regular physical activity, for example by:

- Providing targeted activities or support to involve and encourage the least active children
- Encouraging active play during break times and lunchtimes
- Establishing, extending or funding attendance of school sport clubs and activities and holiday clubs, or broadening the variety offered
- Adopting an active mile initiative
- Raising attainment in primary school swimming to meet requirements of the national curriculum before the end of key stage 2. Every child should leave primary school able to swim.

We will invest the money in:

- Providing teachers with a range of training opportunities working in partnership with local Primary and Secondary schools and organisations in order to improve the quality of planning and delivery as well as teacher skills.
- Provide cover for teachers and PE specialists to work together.
- Organise a range of extra-curricular activities and competitions for our pupils to get involved in sporting activities.
- Promote the Active Daily Mile.
- Support in funding pupils to participate in after school PE and sports clubs.
- Improve our PE provision by investment in indoor and outdoor equipment.
- Promote Healthy School months.
- Promote pupil wellbeing.
- Invest in cycle training to ensure as many children as possible gain this valuable life skill.
- Invest in balance bike training for the Infants.
- Alongside our Eco-Schools committee, work in improving the air quality in the school.
- Promote sustainable modes of travel through BoW SoW WoW (our weekly reward scheme to children who
 come to school on Wednesdays by foot, bike or scooter) this is linked to our Gold level awarded School Travel
 Plan.
