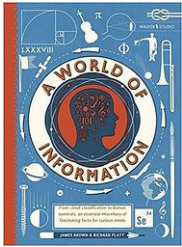

Please be aware this is not a definitive list but a mere suggestion of quality books and authors. We expect children to read anywhere between 30-40 books in a school year.

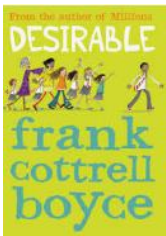
