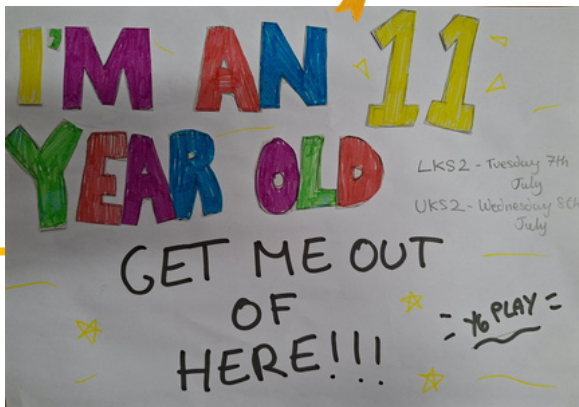
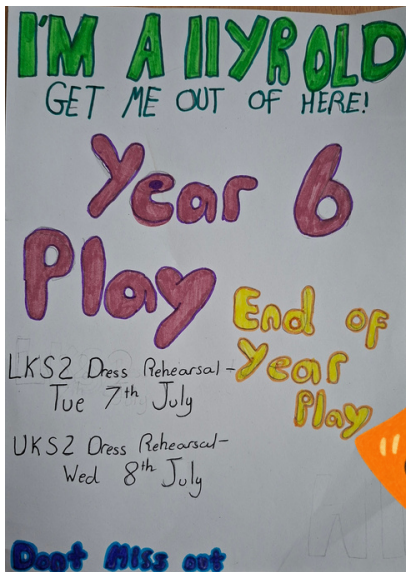
Meet The Team

Marie:

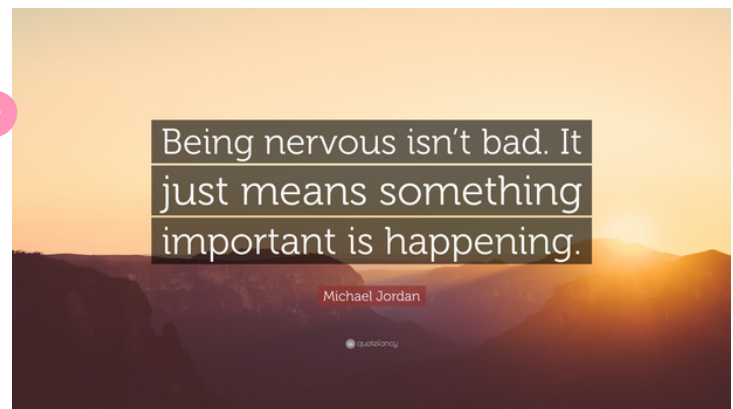
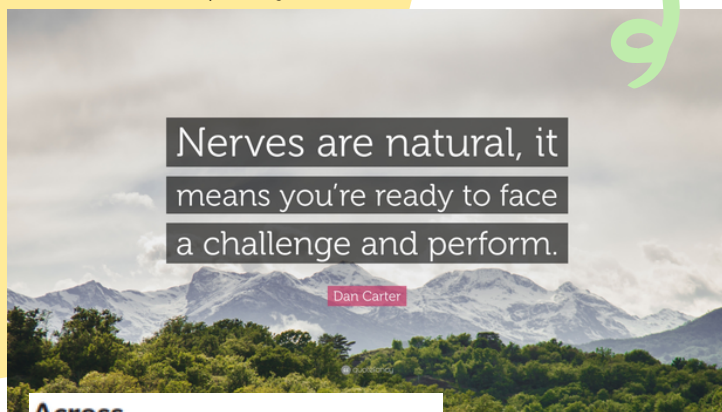

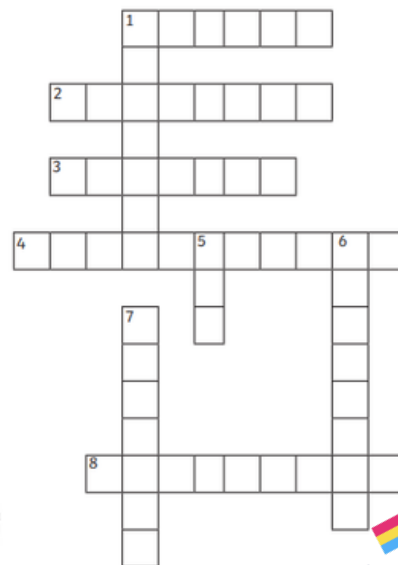

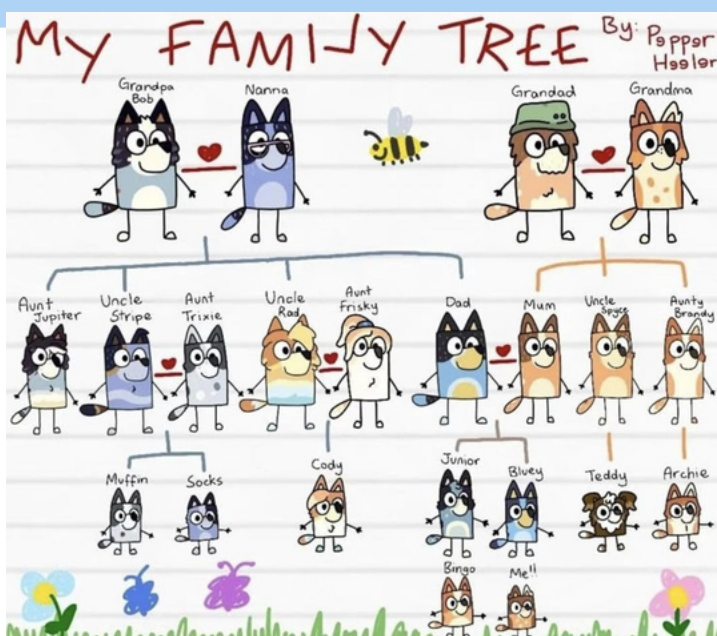
Bluey & Bingo's Friends

- **Diverse Cast:** Bluey's friends and classmates all represent different dog breeds (e.g., Chloe the Dalmatian, Coco the Poodle).

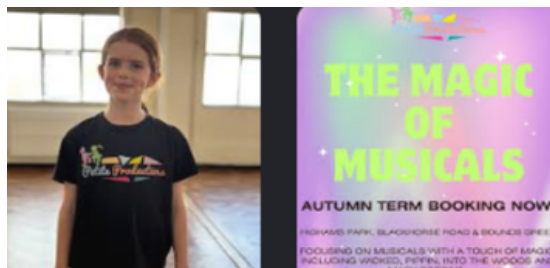


Petite Productions – drama club

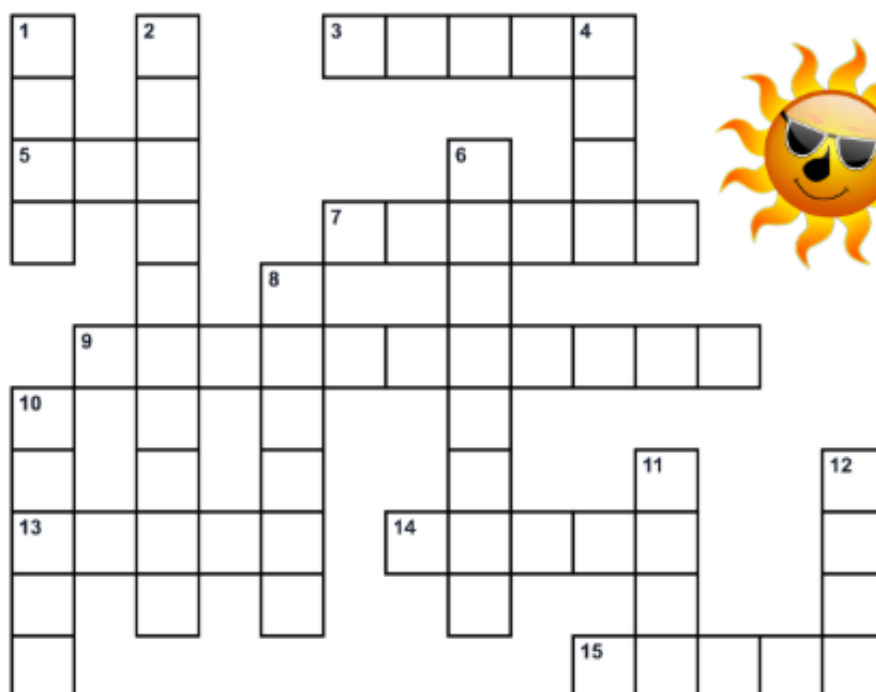
